The District reserves the right to waive irregularities in bids, to reject any or all bids, and to conduct such investigation as necessary to determine the responsibility of a bidder.

These Projects are subject to Ohio's Encouraging Diversity, Growth, and Equity Business Development Program ("EDGE"). A Bidder is required to submit with its Bid, certain information about the certified EDGE Business Enterprise(s) participating on the Projects with the Bidder, as described in the Instructions to Bidders relating to a minimum 5% participation by EDGE businesses.
