Bids will be received by Colonel Crawford Local School District through the State's electronic bidding system at <https://bidexpress.com> until 1:00 pm, local time, on August 6, 2014, when they will be reviewed and tabulated, for asbestos hazard abatement & related work included in an OFCC program project, based upon Contract Documents prepared by Gandee & Associates. A pre-bid meeting will be held at 10:00 am, July 28, 2014, at Colonel Crawford Intermediate School, 2303 State Route 602, North Robinson, Ohio. CAUTION – HAZARDOUS! The total Estimated Contract Costs are: \$315,000 for Base Bid No. 1 Work; \$285,000 for Base Bid No. 2 Work; and \$390,000 for Base Bid No. 3 Work. EDGE requirements apply to this project.

Submit an electronic facsimile of the bid guaranty with the electronic bid form, as described in the Special Conditions to the ITB, and provide an original unaltered guaranty to the School District Treasurer within 3 days after the bid opening. The Bid Guaranty must be in the form of either a Bid Guaranty & Contract Bond for the full amount of the bid (including all add alternates) or a certified check, cashier's check, or an irrevocable letter of credit in an amount equal to 10% of the bid (including all add alternates), as described in the Instructions to Bidders. No Bidder may withdraw its bid within 60 days after the bid opening. The District reserves the right to waive irregularities in bids, to reject any or all bids, and to conduct such investigation as necessary to determine the responsibility of a bidder.
