



Call for Speaker Proposals FAQs

1.	<p>Q: Given the short time limit of 15 minutes, can you advise if more than one speaker would work for one of the presentations? Or are they limited to one speaker?</p> <p>A: One speaker is preferred, but no more than two speakers.</p>
2.	<p>Q: Do firms need to be located in Ohio to participate [submit a speaker proposal]?</p> <p>A: No, it is not required that conference speakers live in Ohio. However, the presentation topic should present a single game-changing innovation to improve <u>public</u> construction.</p>
3.	<p>Q: Are the examples intended to be OFCC funded projects? And OFCC building types? Or would a non-OFCC funded/ building type, yet publicly funded project be acceptable?</p> <p>A: All of these are acceptable topic areas: OFCC funded projects, OFCC building types, non-OFCC funded/building type, but publicly funded projects.</p>
4.	<p>Q: Is the content/sessions all the same for all four events?</p> <p>A: No. The content would essentially be the same at Columbus #1 and Cincinnati, and Cleveland and Columbus #2 conferences.</p>
5.	<p>Q: If we are selected to be a speaker would we be expected to give that same presentation at all four events?</p> <p>A: No. Speakers are asked to select two conferences as noted in Question 4: either Columbus #1 and Cincinnati, or Cleveland and Columbus #2.</p>
