Below are the questions that have been received to date for the RFQ of the above-referenced project:

1. Q. Will OSU be selecting a separate design architect for the project?
  - A. No, there will not be a separate design architect. The RFQ is listed as the Architect of Record only because there is a separate RFQ listed for the MEP Engineer.
2. Q. Is there a preference on which version of the 330 form is used (the new one issued in July or the previous version)?
  - A. The new version should be utilized.
3. Q. Has there been an existing conditions assessment performed on both or either Oxley and Pomerene or will the A/E team be expected to perform this assessment as part of the project?
  - A. There are facility condition assessments that were completed on both buildings last year; that info will be quite useful, but may not be all inclusive and some assessment may be required of the AE team. The assessments will be provided to the shortlisted firms.
4. Q. Are the Ohio State University BIM standards mentioned in the RFQ available for review?
  - A. The Ohio State University BIM standards should be rolled out very soon, but they have not been yet.
