Below are the questions that have been received to date for the RFQ of the above-referenced project:

1. Is this separate from the Regional Program Consultant contract?
 - A. Yes, the Regional Program Consultant RFQ will be posted on February 6, 2017
2. The "Project Name" on the attached posting is a little confusing (i.e., referencing master planning) so just wanted to confirm this RFQ is for "Facility Assessment" and it's not the RPC posting?
 - A. Yes, the Regional Program Consultant RFQ will be posted on February 6, 2017
3. Are MEP firms considered for this RFQ or would it be the intent of the Architect chosen to select the MEP at that time?
 - A. The assessment team will include the MEP services on their team.
4. Can you provide building list and square footage for the Facilities Assessment RFQ?
 - A. The district buildings that will require facility assessments are not yet identified. Districts requiring facility assessments apply to enter into an active planning process for multiple Commission programs.
5. Does qualifying for this work negate our firm's ability to work on other OFCC projects and/or school districts?
 - A. It does not preclude a firm from working with districts but may require the request for a waiver if the firm performs an assessment then wishes to provide design services for same.
6. In the Selection Criteria, Section 1a. – can our sub be EDGE Certified to allow us the 10 points, or does it have to be the prime firm?
 - A. The score sheet used is based on awarding points to only edge primes/lead firms. It doesn't provide extra points for sub consultants.
7. In 1b. is it correct that if we have more than 10 professionals, we would get 0 points?
 - A. This is correct.
