The program establishes goals for state agencies, boards and commissions in awarding contracts to certified EDGE eligible businesses. EDGE applies to procurements of supplies and services, professional services, information technology services, construction and professional design services. PROCUREMENT OPPORTUNITIES AND PROJECT DELIVERY METHODS

OFCC manages the procurement of design and construction services for state agency, higher education and K-12 projects through a variety of delivery methods including qualifications based, best value, and competitive bidding processes. The typical project administered by OFCC is generally >\$1.5 million and includes design professionals, contractors and consultants for new construction, renovations or additions to existing facilities.

Subcontractors are encouraged to contact selected architects, engineers, construction managers at risk or design-build firms early in a project's life cycle to promote their materials or services for consideration into a project's design or specifications.
