Dear OFCC Customer,

This correspondence is to inform you of a recent adjustment in the registration and certification fees through the Green Building Certification Institute. The price increase was effective on December 1, 2016. All new OFCC projects were registered before the price increase was implemented. The registration fee increased from \$900 to \$1200 per school for the basic LEED for Schools registration. This will only impact projects approved for funding after this date. All 2016 and January 2017 approved projects have been registered and paid under Version 3 LEED for Schools. The fees for both Design and Construction Review have been modified. The OFCC uses the LEED for Schools system under the Building Design + Construction rating system. There are sliding scale fees for the reviews based on the square footage of the school. Our schools will typically fall under the 250,000 or less square foot building size. I encourage you to pull down a copy of the fee table for your future reference but below is a summary of the fee changes:

Design Only Review	\$.04	\$.045
Construction Only Review	\$.01	\$.015
Combined D&C Review	\$.045	\$.055
