

**LEGISLATIVE HIGHLIGHTS**  
**MAIN OPERATING BUDGET FY 2018-2019**  
**AMENDED SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 49**

- SFC Abolishment. Eliminates School Facilities Commission and consolidates its duties into the Facilities Construction Commission. Adds four non-voting legislative members to the Facilities Construction Commission.
- Contractor Debarment. Authorizes OFCC to debar individuals in addition to contracting firms.
- Agency Local Administration. Allows OFCC to authorize DAS, Ohio School for the Deaf, and the Ohio School for the Blind to administer capital projects with a cost less than \$1.5 million.
- 1:1 School Facilities Option Program. Creates a new program option for districts once they have been reached on the equity list. Each school district may receive up to the greater of either \$1 million or 10% of the state's share of the district's master plan cost. The district is required to match state funding on a 1:1 basis.
- Alternative Fuel Vehicles. Allows districts to include alternative fuel vehicles and infrastructure into the School Performance Contracting (HB 264) program.
- Community Schools Grants Program. Reappropriates the remaining \$8 million unspent balance for potential use for more grants.
- Cultural Facilities Grants. Creates three new capital appropriations totaling \$1,175,000 for cultural and historical facilities.
