

- 269 districts have completed all necessary construction and renovation work. (Vocational districts in this category include Butler Tech, Collins Career, Gallia-Jackson-Vinton, Knox County, Mid-East Career, Pickaway-Ross, Pike County, Pioneer, Scioto County, Southern Hills, Upper Valley, Vanguard Sentinel, Vantage, and Winne County.)
- 97 districts have had their master facilities plans fully or partially funded. (The Apollo Career Center Vocational District is included in this category.)
- 154 districts have been offered full or partial state funding, but have been unable to raise their required local share or have deferred participation on the program. (Vocational districts in this category include Ashland County, Belmont Harrison, Buckeye, Columbiana County, Coshocton, Four County, Jefferson County, Maplewood, Medina County, Penta, Springfield-Clark County, Stark County, Tri-County, Tri-Rivers, Trumbull County, U.S. Grant, and Washington County.)
