



JVS Eligibility Ranking List

The Ohio School Facilities Commission administers several programs that provide state assistance to school districts in the acquisition, construction, and maintenance of classroom facilities. Each of those programs is centered on the development of a Master Facility Plan that addresses the entire facility needs of a school district. The programs listed on this chart include the Classroom Facilities Assistance Program (CFAP), the Exceptional Needs Program (ENP), and the Expedited Local Partnership Program (ELPP). This chart reflects the program of each district through these three programs towards completion of all necessary facilities work.

Calculation of Project Funding Shares and the Use of Ranking Percentiles

A school district's priority for state assistance from the OSFC is based on the district's three-year average "adjusted valuation per pupil," as calculated by the Ohio Department of Education. Under that calculation, the district's taxable "valuation per pupil" is modified by a factor reflecting the income of the district (A district's valuation is the total value of all property in the district as assessed for tax purposes.) All districts are annually ranked from lowest to highest adjusted valuation per pupil and placed in percentiles. A district's percentile ranking determines when the district will be served by CFAP. Also, for each district, the portion of the basic project cost paid by the district is equal to its percentile ranking. For example, a district ranked in the 20th percentile would pay 20% of the project cost and the state would pay the remaining 80%. For some districts, the district portion of the project cost is calculated under an alternative formula based on the district's existing permanent improvement debt. In this alternative formulation, relative wealth is also a factor. OSFC is required by law to use the calculation methods for the district's local share.
