Below are the questions that have been received to date for the RFQ of the above-referenced project:

1. In the subject RFQ, Section A – Project Description, there is reference to “work at a National Natural Landmark”

In RFQ, Section B – Scope of Services, there are references to “National Historic Landmark historic preservation requirements...and historic preservation projects

My question: Should the term “historic” in RFP Section B actually be “natural”, or is the document correct as written?

- A. It should be “natural.”
2. What special arrangements, if any, does the State have for Consultant transportation to, from, and on the island?
 - A. There are no special arrangements at this time, however if needed, those would be made with the selected firm as part of fee negotiations.
3. Would it be possible to utilize terrestrial scanning in place of or in conjunction with the drone deliverables?
 - A. ODNR is interested in any new technologies proposed to assess the current conditions of the site.
4. Will the project limits marked out in a .kmz file or on an aerial photo to enable us to see the approximate limits and to make sure that the area is not obstructed by foliage to ensure that the drone will be able to capture the entire desired area.
 - A. Surveying services are to be provided by the selected firm. The project limits should be delineated in the survey and subsequently used for all aspects of the assessment, including aerial photography, lidar or other drone deliverables.
