# **Project Overview**

# A. Project Description

This Request for Qualifications is for a single professional services agreement. The services to be provided will be for two concurrent projects. The service building at each of 3 sites (1 at DOT-190001; 2 at DOT-190002) will be identical except for consideration of applicable code and occupant requirements, and availability of utilities. Site development will respond to existing improvements and conditions, and Owner goals at each of the three sites. Each project will be bid for construction services and administered separately.

#### DOT-190001: ASHTABULA

The project consists of the demolition of the existing buildings, picnic facilities, walks, curbs, and some clearing of trees; a rest area service building constructed with associated picnic areas; and site improvements including sidewalks, curbs, etc. The work includes site improvements to the storm sewer system, underdrains, utilities to serve the buildings, upgrades to the site/security lighting, and landscaping. To the fullest extent possible, existing approaches, drives, tractor-trailer parking, and vehicular parking are to remain. The Architect/Engineer (A/E) will prepare the POR as an Additional Service. All aspects of the project and related issues will be implemented and operated consistent with the Contracting Authority's policies and procedures.

# DOT-190002: PORTAGE

The project consists of the demolition of existing buildings; picnic facilities, walks and curbs; and some clearing of trees; new rest area service buildings constructed with associated picnic areas; and site improvements including sidewalks, curbs, etc. The work includes site improvements to the storm sewer system, underdrains, utilities to serve the buildings, upgrades to the site/security lighting, and landscaping. The work will also include providing compliant potable water and sewage treatments by restoration, remodeling, or replacement of the existing facilities based on investigation, testing and analysis of the current systems by the AE. To the fullest extent possible, existing approaches, drives, tractor-trailer parking, and vehicular parking are to remain. The Architect/Engineer (A/E) will prepare the POR as an Additional Service. All aspects of the project and related issues will be implemented and operated consistent with the Contracting Authority's policies and procedures.

# B. Scope of Services

For projects advertised with an appropriately developed Program of Requirements (POR), upon award of the Agreement, commence with Design. For projects without such a POR, upon award of the Agreement, commence by developing the Program of Requirements.

The selected A/E, as a portion of its required Scope of Services and prior to submitting its proposals, will discuss and clarify with the Owner and/or the Contracting Authority, the cost breakdown of the Architect/Engineer Agreement detailed

cost components to address the Owner's project requirements. Participate in the Encouraging Growth, Diversity & Equity (EDGE) Program as required by statute and the Agreement.

As required by the Agreement, and as properly authorized, provide the following categories of services: Program Verification, Schematic Design, Design Development, Construction Document Preparation, Bid and Award Support, Conformed Documents, Construction Administration, Post-Construction, and Additional Services of all types.

ARTICLE 3 - SCHEMATIC DESIGN of the Exhibit B - A/E Scope of Services calls for "practical alternative design concepts for the purpose of minimizing future energy consumption." This agreement will be supplemented to expand the Life Cycle Cost Analysis to include minimizing future maintenance costs. Each alternate design concept will also address the cost of construction with respect to the construction duration and associated weather cycles.

Design concepts will include the ODOT prototype rest area service building design and at a minimum 2 other concepts of alternate building envelope construction, i.e. "stick framing with masonry veneer, composite siding, etc. Each concept will utilize the ODOT prototype rest area service building floor plan, and building elevations as modified to comply with applicable code and occupant requirements, and availability of utilities.

During the construction period, provide not less than 8 hours (excluding travel time) on-site construction administration services each week, including (1) attendance at progress meetings, (2) a written field report of each site visit, (3) on-site representation comprised of the A/E and its consultant staff involved in the primary design of the project, all having relevant and appropriate types of construction administration experience.

- Proposer's previous experience (numbers of projects, sizes of projects) when working with its proposed consultants.
- Specification writing credentials and experience.
- Proximity of prospective firms to the project site.
- Proposer's apparent resources and capacity to meet the needs of this project.
- The selected A/E and all its consultants must have the capability to use the Internet within their normal business location(s) during normal business hours.

Interested A/E firms are required to submit the Commitment to Participate in the EDGE Business Assistance Program form in its Statement of Qualifications (Form F110-330) submitted in response to the RFQ, to indicate its intent to contract with and use EDGE-certified Business Enterprise(s), as a part of the A/E's team. The Intent to Contract and to Perform and / or waiver request letter and Demonstration of Good Faith Effort form(s) with complete documentation must be attached to the A/E's Technical Proposal.
