Project Overview

A. Project Description

Miami Redhawk Women's Varsity Soccer has competed in NCAA Division 1 soccer in the Mid American Conference since 1997 and seeks at this time to enhance its competition field complex. The team competes on a natural grass soccer pitch located on the east side of the Yager Stadium sports complex. The complex poses opportunities for improvement related to spectator seating, connectivity to adjacent facilities, and the field conditions. This project will address these concerns by constructing a new plaza and connecting pathway, installation of sports field lighting, installation of a new sound system, and development of options for a new bleacher and press box structure. Please note, several of these items fall outside the advertised construction budget and shall be developed and bid as alternates.

A program and conceptual design package has been developed for the project. This request is for an Architect/Engineer (A/E) to provide design and project management for all post-program design phases, utilizing the already established design concepts and beginning with schematic design, through construction documents, bidding, construction and post-construction phases. Engineering Consultants will be selected by and will be contracted by the A/E.

A General Contractor will be selected and contracted directly with the University. The A/E will participate in the selection process by vetting the apparent low bidder and issuing their recommendations.

The project delivery method is "single prime" General Contracting.

B. Scope of Services

Upon Contract award, the A/E's services shall commence with a combined Schematic Design/Design Development set utilizing the direction set forth in the program document, immediately followed by construction and bidding documents.

The selected Architect/Engineer (A/E), as a portion of its required Scope of Services and prior to submitting its proposals, will discuss and clarify with the Owner and/or the Contracting Authority, the cost breakdown of the Architect/Engineer Agreement detailed cost components to address the Owner's project requirements. Participate in the Encouraging Growth, Diversity & Equity (EDGE) Program as required by statute and the Agreement.

As required by the Agreement, and as properly authorized, provide the following categories of services: Design Development, Construction Document Preparation, Bid and Award Support, Conformed Documents, Construction Administration, Post-Construction, and Additional Services of all types.

Refer to the *Ohio Facilities Construction Manual* for additional information about the type and extent of services required for each. A copy of the standard Agreement can be obtained at the OFCC website at <http://ofcc.ohio.gov>.

During the construction period, provide not less than 2 hours (excluding travel time) on-site construction administration services each week, including (1) attendance at progress meetings, (2) a written field report of each site visit, (3) on-site

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representation comprised of the A/E and its consultant staff involved in the primary design of the project, all having relevant and appropriate types of construction administration experience.

- Past performance of prospective firm and its proposed consultants.
- Qualifications and experience of individuals directly involved with the project.
- Proposer's previous experience (numbers of projects, sizes of projects) when working with its proposed consultants.
- Experience and capabilities of creating or using Critical Path Method (CPM) schedules and of using CPM schedules as a project management resource.

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- Approach to and success of using partnering and Alternative Dispute Resolution.
- Proximity of prospective firms to the project site.
- Proposer's apparent resources and capacity to meet the needs of this project.
- The selected A/E and all its consultants must have the capability to use the Internet within their normal business location(s) during normal business hours.

Interested A/E firms are required to submit the Commitment to Participate in the EDGE Business Assistance Program form in its Statement of Qualifications (Form F110-330) submitted in response to the RFQ, to indicate its intent to contract with and use EDGE-certified Business Enterprise(s), as a part of the A/E's team. The Intent to Contract and to Perform and / or waiver request letter and Demonstration of Good Faith Effort form(s) with complete documentation must be attached to the A/E's Technical Proposal. Both forms can be accessed via the OFCC website at <http://ofcc.ohio.gov>. The Intent to Contract and to Perform form is again required at the Fee Proposal stage.
